Current Age

Recent history of persecution is retold symbolically, giving comfort to the faithful God knows what's going on and hasn't abandoned them

End of the Age

Day of the Lord is predicted: God triumphantly intervenes to defeat, judge, and punish the oppressors

Future Age

Following the judgement, God's faithful are vindicated and enjoy a time of peace and communion

Numerology

- 3 = Spirit world
- 4 = Created world
- 10 = Inclusiveness
- 12 = People of God

7 = Something completed or fulfilled 3 1/2 = Something not completed or fulfilled

- Length of time God allows evil to reign
- 3 1/2 years = 42 months = 1260 days = "a time, two times, and half a time"

Combination Examples

- 144,000 = 12x12x10x10x10 = all the people of God
- 1600 stadia = 4x4x10x10x10 = all the world

Creatures

Beasts = nations Heads or horns = leaders Used to retell familiar history

Acts of Nature

Earthquakes = God at work Lightning = God at work Thunder = God at work Floods = God at work Wind = God at work Hail = God at work

<u>Colors</u>

White = victory Red = war Black = absense of something Pale (or green/gray) = death
